JUDGMENT

- (1) The Court **DECLARES** that Defendant Abdul Jabbar Najj Shalabi f/k/a Abdul Jabbar Najj Abdul Jaber illegally procured his citizenship by failing to meet the continuous residence requirement of 8 U.S.C. § 1427(a);
- (2) Judgment is **ENTERED** in favor of Plaintiff United States of America and against Defendant;
- (3) The order admitting Defendant to United States citizenship is **REVOKED** and **SET ASIDE** and Certificate of Naturalization No. 29516121 is **CANCELED**, effective as of the original date of the order and certificate, December 6, 2005;
- (4) Defendant is hereby **RESTRAINED** and **ENJOINED** from claiming any rights, privileges, benefits, or advantages under any document which

evidences United States citizenship obtained as a result of his December 6, 2005 naturalization;

- (5) Defendant is **ORDERED**, within ten (10) days of Judgment, to surrender and deliver his Certificate of Naturalization, as well as any copies thereof in his possession or control (and to make good faith efforts to recover and then surrender any copies thereof that he knows are in the possession or control of others), to the Attorney General, or his representative, including counsel for the United States; and
- (6) Defendant is **ORDERED**, within ten (10) days of Judgment, to surrender and deliver any other indicia of U.S. citizenship, including, but not limited to, United States passports and passport cards; voter registration cards and other voting documents; enhanced drivers licenses or state identification reflecting Defendant's citizenship status; as well as any copies thereof in his possession, custody, or control (and to make good faith efforts to recover and then surrender any copies thereof that he knows are in the possession or control of others), to the Attorney General, or his representative, including counsel for the United States.
