AHMAD SHAH SENT FAX (April 19) TO THE

Chaharun (Saudi Arabia)-April 19:

A message fax (in Arabic) sent by Commander Ahmad Shah Masud from Afghanistan (addressed to Prof. Rabbani in Peshawar) was widely circulated in the massjids of Saudi Arabia by members of the above mentioned agency. This fax contradicts the 'dignity' picture being painted by the Western media and their subscribers. In this respect the fax enlightens us as follows:

- (1) Their is very good understanding and coordination between Ahmad Shah's Mujahideen fighters positioned north of Kabul and Engineer Gulabuddin Hekmatiar's Mujahideen fighters positioned in the south.
- (2) Hekmatiar ordered his fighters in the northern region to assist Ahmad Shah.
- (3) Ahmad Shah urged the leaders of the Mujahideen groups to form a government as soon as possible.
- (4) Iranian Dirty Game exposed: The Iranians sent a commando force to the airbase captured and being controlled by Masud. One of the missions of the commandos was apparently to steal the Mig fighter aircrafts in the airbase. A fighting ensued between the Mujahideen guards and the Iranian commandos; the latter ran away with two stolen MIGs.
