THE GRAND JURY CHARGES:

COUNT ONE

(Attempting to provide material support or resources to a designated foreign terrorist organization)

From between in or about January 2017, to in or about October 2024, in the Southern

District of Texas and elsewhere within the jurisdiction of the Court, defendant,

ANAS SAID,

did knowingly attempt to provide material support and resources, to wit: personnel (himself) and services, including producing videos and propaganda, to a foreign terrorist organization, namely, the Islamic State of Iraq and al-Sham (ISIS), which at all relevant times was designated by the Secretary of State, knowing that ISIS was a designated foreign terrorist organization, and that ISIS

had engaged in and was engaging in terrorist activity and terrorism.
